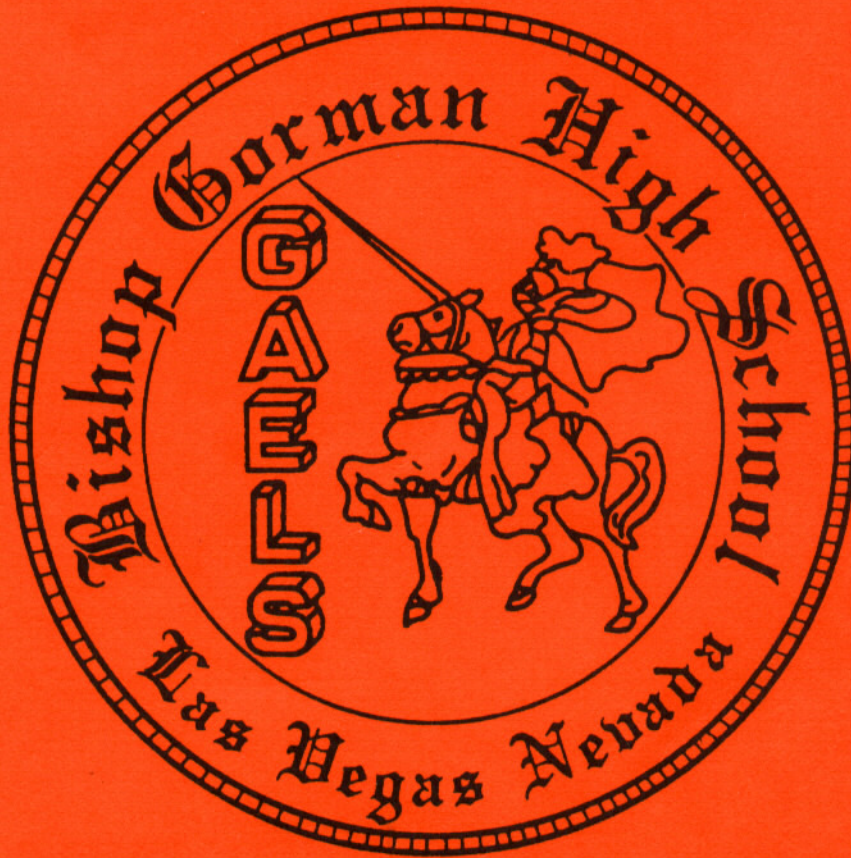

Vicki Cali Ham serves on the Employment Security

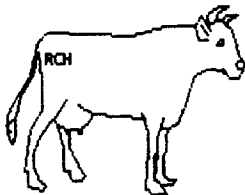

Betty Sina Stewart has extensive travels through Boulder City, Mesquite, Overton, Beatty, Echo Bay and the desert across the street.

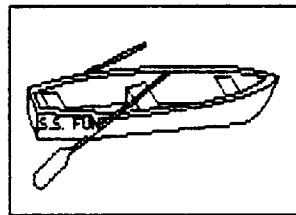
